Just As the Lord Commanded Moses

Exodus Chapter 39

Since Chapter 25, Moses has been receiving instructions from God on Mount Sinai. Moses has spent 80 days with the Lord taking detailed notes because he has been instructed that he needs to construct all that God is showing him. But he hasn't yet had the opportunity to tell Israel what was shown him.

Chapters 35-40 is Moses telling the Children of Israel and then Israel, in turn following those instructions

Exd 39:1	<u>1) The Priest's Tailors</u> v. 1 - 31 Moreover, from the blue and purple and scarlet {material,} they made finely woven garments for ministering in the holy place as well as the holy garments which were for Aaron, just as the LORD had commanded Moses.
Exd 39:2	He made the ephod of gold, {and} of blue and purple and scarlet {material,} and fine twisted linen.
Exd 39:3	Then they hammered out gold sheets and cut {them} into threads to be woven in {with} the blue and the purple and the scarlet {material,} and the fine linen, the work of a skillful workman.
Exd 39:4	They made attaching shoulder pieces for the ephod; it was attached at its two {upper} ends.
Exd 39:5	The skillfully woven band which was on it was like its workmanship, of the same material: of gold {and} of blue and purple and scarlet {material,} and fine twisted linen, just as the LORD had commanded Moses.
Exd 39:6	They made the onyx stones, set in gold filigree {settings;} they were engraved {like} the engravings of a signet, according to the names of the sons of Israel.
Exd 39:7	 And he placed them on the shoulder pieces of the ephod, {as} memorial stones for the sons of Israel, just as the LORD had commanded Moses. Made Aaron's Ephod as told to Moses in Exodus 28:5-14
Exd 39:8	He made the breastpiece, the work of a skillful workman, like the workmanship of the ephod: of gold {and} of blue and purple and scarlet {material} and fine twisted linen.
Exd 39:9	It was square; they made the breastpiece folded double, a span long and a span wide when folded double.
Exd 39:10	And they mounted four rows of stones on it. The first row {was} a row of ruby, topaz, and emerald;
Exd 39:11	and the second row, a turquoise, a sapphire and a diamond;
Exd 39:12	and the third row, a jacinth, an agate, and an amethyst;
Exd 39:13	and the fourth row, a beryl, an onyx, and a jasper. They were set in gold filigree {settings} when they were mounted.
Exd 39:14	The stones were corresponding to the names of the sons of Israel; they were twelve, corresponding to their names, {engraved with} the engravings of a signet, each with its name for the twelve tribes.
Exd 39:15	They made on the breastpiece chains like cords, of twisted cordage work in pure gold.
Exd 39:16	They made two gold filigree {settings} and two gold rings, and put the two rings on the two ends of the breastpiece.
Exd 39:17	Then they put the two gold cords in the two rings at the ends of the breastpiece.
Exd 39:18	They put the {other} two ends of the two cords on the two filigree {settings,} and put them on the shoulder pieces of the ephod at the front of it.

- Exd 39:19 They made two gold rings and placed {them} on the two ends of the breastpiece, on its inner edge which was next to the ephod.
- Exd 39:20 Furthermore, they made two gold rings and placed them on the bottom of the two shoulder pieces of the ephod, on the front of it, close to the place where it joined, above the woven band of the ephod.
- Exd 39:21 They bound the breastpiece by its rings to the rings of the ephod with a blue cord, so that it would be on the woven band of the ephod, and that the breastpiece would not come loose from the ephod, just as the LORD had commanded Moses.
 - Made Aaron's Breastpiece as told to Moses in Exodus 28:15-29
- Exd 39:22 Then he made the robe of the ephod of woven work, all of blue;
- Exd 39:23 and the opening of the robe was {at the top} in the center, as the opening of a coat of mail, with a binding all around its opening, so that it would not be torn.
- Exd 39:24 They made pomegranates of blue and purple and scarlet {material and} twisted {linen} on the hem of the robe.
- Exd 39:25 They also made bells of pure gold, and put the bells between the pomegranates all around on the hem of the robe,
- Exd 39:26 alternating a bell and a pomegranate all around on the hem of the robe for the service, just as the LORD had commanded Moses.
 - Made Aaron's Robe as told to Moses in Exodus 28:31-35
- Exd 39:27 They made the tunics of finely woven linen for Aaron and his sons,
- Exd 39:28 and the turban of fine linen, and the decorated caps of fine linen, and the linen breeches of fine twisted linen,
- Exd 39:29 and the sash of fine twisted linen, and blue and purple and scarlet {material,} the work of the weaver, just as the LORD had commanded Moses.
 - Made Priestly Tunics, Turbans, Sash and Undergarment as told to Moses in Exodus 28:39-43
- Exd 39:30 They made the plate of the holy crown of pure gold, and inscribed it like the engravings of a signet, "Holy to the LORD."
- Exd 39:31 They fastened a blue cord to it, to fasten it on the turban above, just as the LORD had commanded Moses.
 - Made Aaron's Turban as told to Moses in Exodus 28:36-38

Exd 39:32 2) The Building Inspector v. 32 - 43

Thus all the work of the tabernacle of the tent of meeting was completed; and the sons of Israel did according to all that the LORD had commanded Moses; so they did.

- Exd 39:33 They brought the tabernacle to Moses, the tent and all its furnishings: its clasps, its boards, its bars, and its pillars and its sockets;
- Exd 39:34 and the covering of rams' skins dyed red, and the covering of porpoise skins, and the screening veil;
- Exd 39:35 the ark of the testimony and its poles and the mercy seat;
- Exd 39:36 the table, all its utensils, and the bread of the Presence;
- Exd 39:37 the pure {gold} lampstand, with its arrangement of lamps and all its utensils, and the oil for the light;
- Exd 39:38 and the gold altar, and the anointing oil and the fragrant incense, and the veil for the doorway of the tent;

- Exd 39:39 the bronze altar and its bronze grating, its poles and all its utensils, the laver and its stand;
- Exd 39:40 the hangings for the court, its pillars and its sockets, and the screen for the gate of the court, its cords and its pegs and all the equipment for the service of the tabernacle, for the tent of meeting;
- Exd 39:41 the woven garments for ministering in the holy place and the holy garments for Aaron the priest and the garments of his sons, to minister as priests.
- Exd 39:42 So the sons of Israel did all the work according to all that the LORD had commanded Moses.
- Exd 39:43 And Moses examined all the work and behold, they had done it; just as the LORD had commanded, this they had done. So Moses blessed them.
 - The people completed all the items commanded.
 - The People brought them to Moses.
 - Moses inspected all the work that was done.
 - "BEHOLD THEY HAD DONE IT JUST AS THE LORD HAD COMMANDED:
 - Moses Blessed them.
